

Church Building Update

1-29-2020

As last reported the City of Lynnwood approved the Land Use Permit. This means that they approved the concept for the Narthex addition. We now need to get building permits before we can start construction.

At this time, we are working with the architect to complete construction drawings and specification to submit to the City for the permits. That process has not yet been completed. At the same time, we are working with select subcontractors to design and price their portion of the work. Those subcontractors are primarily the electrical, HVAC, and structural subcontractor that will repair the beams. The electrical subcontractor is giving us options on lighting packages and the work necessary to provide for the electrical needs of the Narthex addition. The HVAC Subcontractor is giving us proposals for a new heating system for the church as the current system is on its last legs. They are also doing proposals for the heating system for the Narthex addition.

Once the work is completed for the permit submission, we will begin to work on the upgrades for the interior which is planned to consist of new windows, a new altar platform as well as a new altar and other liturgical items. We will also be soliciting proposals for a new audio-visual system. All of these items are dependent on not exceeding our available construction funds.

We will be using the bulletin as well as the Church web site for the official communication on the status of the church remodel project. There may also be pulpit announcements and town hall meetings for updates but the primary means will be written updates in the bulletin or inserts in the bulletin. Any other updates you may get or hear may not be as up to date or as accurate as what will be in the bulletin. As we reach certain events, like receiving permits, or milestones those will be communicated to the church community. As we get updated renderings and drawings those will be posted online and in the Narthex.
